Marriage License Requirements

- 1. Applicants should be 18 years of age or older. An applicant of 17 years can apply if a parent appears to give written consent to the marriage. **Must provide valid photo I.D.**
- 2. There is a **3 day waiting period** from the date of application until the license becomes effective (counts the day purchasing the license). Once the license is valid, it is usable for a period of **60** days.
- 3. The license fee is \$54.00 (includes certified copy for name change and/or legal purposes).
- 4. The County Clerk's fee to perform a marriage is \$110.00 as per HB2795.
- 5. The form requires information on your parents. You will need to know your mother's maiden name and the state both parents were born. If either applicant has ever been married, you will need to know the finalization date of the last marriage.
- 6. An Oregon Marriage License can only be used in Oregon.

<u>Important Notice – Please Read</u>

106.020 Prohibited and voided marriages. The following marriages are prohibited and, if solemnized within this state, are absolutely void:

- (1) When either party thereto had a wife or husband living at the time of such marriage.
- (2) When the parties thereto are first cousins or any nearer of kin to each other, whether of the whole of half-blood, whether by blood or adoption, computing by the rules of the civil law, except that when the parties are first cousins by adoption only, the marriage is not prohibited or void. [Amended by 1989 c.647 S1]
- * Baker County interprets ORS 106.150 "in the presence of" to mean the couple, officiant, and two witnesses must be physically present in the same room, without the use of any electronic means such as Skype or telephone, throughout the ceremony.
