ORDINANCE NO. 2025-06

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners of Baker County, Oregon adopted Ordinance No. 2017-05, setting regulations for mineral leasing rules on County property; and

WHEREAS said ordinance established a procedure for leasing mineral rights on County properties; and

WHEREAS the Baker County Board of Commissioners believes it to be in the best interest of Baker County and its citizens to discontinue the availability of county property for mineral leasing; and

WHEREAS, the Baker County Board of Commissioners now finds it in the best interest of the County and its citizens to formally rescind said ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Baker County Board of Commissioners that: 1) Ordinance No. 2017-05 is hereby rescinded in its entirety, as of the date of signature.
